The Kendal & District Bowling League - KDBL Cup Competition Illustrative examples of how the matches would work

Example 1

The start time of matches will be the normal time that practice would commence for a league game at that date. The preliminary round (8 teams will take part in this to bring the 36 entries down to 32) will aim to be the only one scheduled to commence at the start time of 6pm, being played in the first four weeks of the season.

Due to the early start time, Victoria A only send one car to Allithwaite for the start of the match for this example tie. Two players are unavailable so they intend to play the other six, with Alan Gilpin and Ian Nicholson arriving later. Allithwaite A choose to play all of their eight players.

The captains write out their opponents names from each others sheet, making the matchups random draw. If the sheets have not been pre-populated then they would make a draw to decide who plays whom on the night.

Allithwiate A start each game on +2 because they are a division 2 side, whilst Victoria A start on +2 as well because they a division 1 side playing away from home.

The match starts with the doubles games and once they have come off the green the singles are played. If there are any matching singles where players are not playing in the doubles you can also put one of these on the green at the same time, making it 3 games then 3 games for the match format. Allithwaite A ask to do this (as their green is small) and when Alan Gilpin arrives at 6:15pm his game with Bill Wilson commences.

At 7pm Ian Nicholson has not arrived due to traffic returning home from work. Victoria A select Terry Mercer to take his place in the singles.

At the end of the games, the match is tied on wins and aggregate, so each captain selects a player to compete in a best of 5 ends game to determine the winner. Martin Gilpin leads off the first end (as he is away from home) and is victorious 3-1 to send Victoria A into the first round proper.

Example 2

Victoria A are away to Holme A in the second round, commencing at 6:30pm. Both are division 1 sides, so Victoria start each game 2-0 as the away team.

Both teams decide to pick just 4 players to compete in the match and whilst Holme A end with a better aggregate, Victoria A pick up 4 wins so move on to the next round.

Example 3

In the second round Victoria A come up against fellow club team Victoria C. Here neither side has home advantage so the handicapping on the cards will purely be determined by their league placings, i.e. Victoria C starting each game 4-0 in front. Being as the club have floodlights, they agree a start-time of 7pm between them. The match finishes 3-3 so the winner is then determined on aggregate, with Victoria A progressing to the quarter finals.
