

The Rules of the Kendal & District Bowling League Super 32 Competition

Qualification

Entrants will qualify for the event through their performance the season before as follows:

- The defending champion
- The top 19 merit players in division 1
- The top 5 merit players in division 2
- The merit winner from divisions 3, 4, 5 & 6
- The championship event winner from divisions 1, 2 & 3

Where any player qualifies but is unavailable or uninterested in taking part they will be replaced by the next best in the merit tables from that same division.

Date and Venue

The competition will take place on the Sunday immediately prior the league season commencing.

The league committee will select the best venue available, with priority given as follows:

- 1) Good parking and facilities
- 2) Good condition of the green

The venue decision and qualifying criteria for the following season will be made by the end of June each year.

Handicapping

The competition will be handicapped as follows:

- Division 1 qualifiers start on scratch
- Division 2 qualifiers +2
- Division 3 qualifiers +3
- Division 4 qualifiers +4
- Division 5 & 6 qualifiers +5

No player in the league ranking system (four year merit table) shall receive a positive handicap.

Any home player will face a 1 point deduction from their handicap.

Seeding and Draw

The top 16 qualifiers will be seeded into the competition based on their order in the 4 year merit table. Once all entrants have been established the league committee shall randomly draw the other 16 entrants into this grid.

Once the draw has been made (approximately 4 weeks before) the entrants included will be liable for any entrance monies due, regardless of whether they turn up on the day.

Entrance Fees and Prize Money

Each qualifier will be required to pay £5 to play in the competition, which will all (+ sponsorship received) be paid out on the day.
