Notices of Motion for the 2024 Annual General Meeting

Proposal from the League's Executive Committee:

The adoption of the amalgamated rules for the league, as per the attached document.

If the above is passed, there are no further notices of motion.

If the above is declined on mass, then it will be opened to establish whether there are any specific sections of the new rules that members are unhappy with. If this is the case, then each of those sections will be discussed and voted on separately as to whether they are kept as per the new rules or substituted for an equivalent section of the old rules.

If it is not possible to agree the new rules, then they will be discarded, and the following notice of motion will be discussed:

Proposed by Staveley Bowling Club:

Amendment to rule M5.

To completely remove reference to Clubs with flood lights.

"All league and cup matches throughout the season to commence at 7 pm. Where light is an issue at the beginning and end of a season, then games will commence at 6.30pm or sooner at the discretion of both captains".

Reasoning being: Clubs without floodlights start at 6.30pm at the beginning and end of the season and teams from Clubs, that have floodlights, have to abide by this, so let's standardise the start times across all Clubs, to save confusion.

Staveley have been caught out this season by arriving early to games and having to sit and wait for over half an hour on some very cold evenings.
